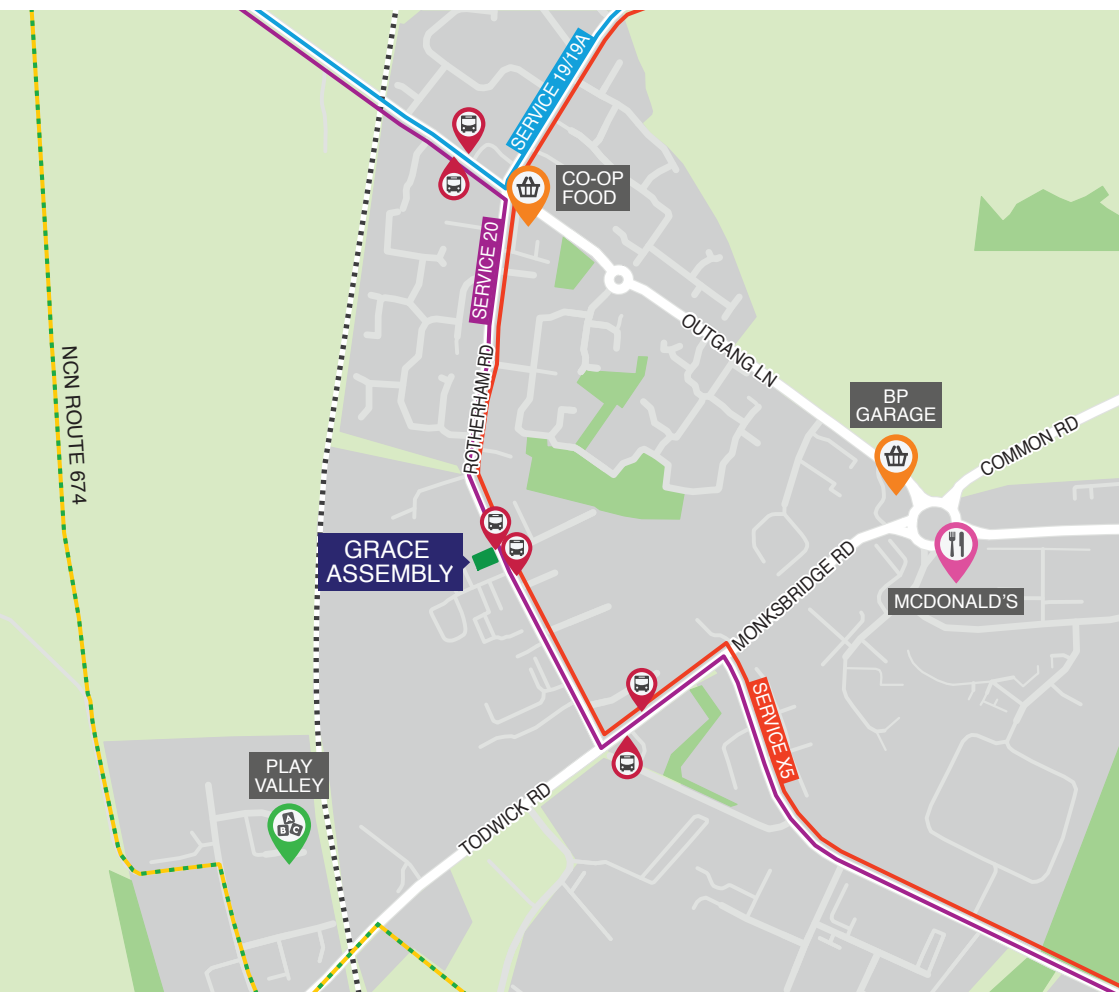

NEW SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

To help support the congregation to travel to RCCG Grace Assembly and reduce car travel, the church is offering a dedicated shuttle service on Sundays! With multiple round trips, **pickup will be between around 9am and 9:30am and drop off at between around 12:30pm and 1pm**, ensuring flexibility around Sunday services.

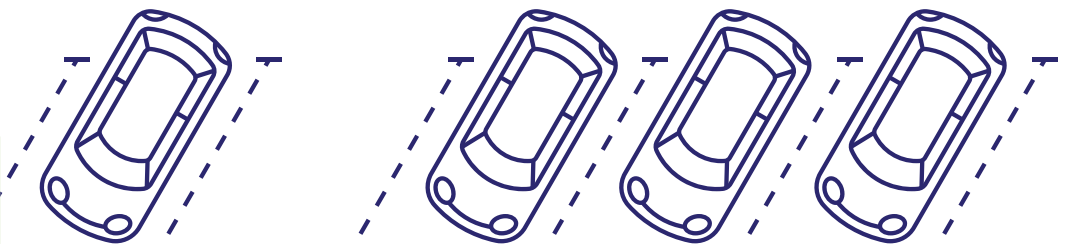


RIDE SHARING

Using the shuttle bus isn't the only way you can reduce car use. If you know someone who lives on or close to your route to church, why not consider offering them a lift? Alongside supporting your congregation, ride sharing can help reduce your impact on the planet and help you get to know the people around you.

Parking at the new church and community centre in Dinnington is limited, so please consider alternatives to driving where possible, or share your journey with others to reduce demand. Doing so will help ensure that the spaces are available for those who need them, and will minimise our impact on the roads in the local community.

To get started, why not start an informal sign up list on a community board or ask around?



LET'S GET ACTIVE

CYCLING

Cycling can also be a practical option for journeys to Grace Assembly. Rotherham Road forms part of the 'South Yorkshire by Bike' route and is specifically classified as a family-friendly section of the route. Locally it provides connections towards Thurcroft and Dinnington centre.

For longer journeys, National Cycle Network (NCN) Route 674 can be accessed nearby via Todwick Road, providing onward links towards North Anston, Laughton Common and Woodsetts. Check out the map at the start of the guide to see where the route runs locally.

Cycle parking is available by the side of the church building, just make sure you bring your own lock along to secure your bike to the stands.



CYCLESTREETS:

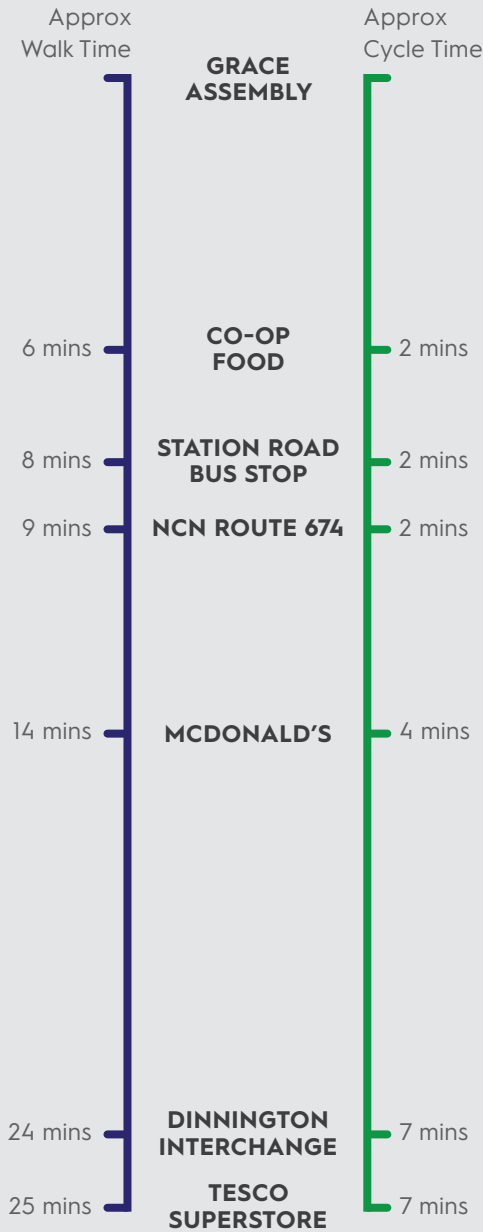
To help plan your journey, why not check out the **Cycle Streets** website? Here you can add your starting point and end destination, and the website will offer multiple routes for your journey, offering a breakdown of each route and helping you pick based on difficulty and distance.



WALKING

Walking is often one of the simplest and most enjoyable ways to travel. It provides an opportunity to slow down, reflect, and prepare for worship, while also benefiting physical health and reducing environmental impact. For those who live nearby, a short walk can be a practical alternative to driving and may help ease parking demand around the church.

With the right footwear, weather-appropriate clothing, and enough time set aside for your journey, walking to church can become a really rewarding part of your Sunday routine.



OTHER PUBLIC TRANSPORT OPTIONS

If you are travelling to the site during the week or on a Saturday, why not choose a local bus to get to Grace Assembly? Please note, the following services do not run on a Sunday, where you can instead take advantage of the Shuttle Bus (see page 3).

Bus services to Sheffield and Rotherham both provide access to onwards travel on the Supertram network, which connects with a number of areas across Sheffield.

WHERE ARE THE NEAREST BUS STOPS?

The nearest bus stops to the site can be found along Rotherham Road and Station Road, both within a 10-minute walk from Grace Assembly. Check out our map on page one to see these stops.

From Rotherham Road:

Service X5

Sheffield – Maltby

This service runs past Grace Assembly approximately hourly between 7am and 6pm, in each direction. However, if caught from Dinnington Interchange, the service operates between Sheffield and Dinnington every 30 minutes. On Saturdays the service only operates between around 10am and 2pm.

Operated by First Bus.

Service 20

Rotherham – Dinnington

This service runs three times a day, in each direction, Monday to Saturday.

Operated by TM Travel.

From Station Road:

Service 19/19A

Worksop - Rotherham

These services combine to offer a bus every half an hour during the day, in each direction. Services start at around 5am and run through to 8pm.

Operated by Stagecoach.
